Here is some information that is good to know:

We have a board at the dormitory, which everyone is welcome to join. There is a chairman, treasurer, common room manager and deputies. Here we talk about what to spend our money on, what social events would be fun, etc. Among other things, we've got hammocks down in the garden. That way, you can participate in shaping our home. There's always a notice in the basement with the names of the current board, to which you can always write with suggestions etc.

For many of us, the garden is our favourite place in the summer. In the shed you can find sun loungers, garden games etc. which are all free to use - just remember to put things back in their place. Your key to your apartment etc. also works for the garden gate - remember to lock it when you're in the garden (we've had problems with intruders in the garden) and when you leave the garden.

The common room is a great place to have a party! Simply write to the common room manager and pay a deposit, which will be returned when the room is returned in good condition. In addition, you post on Facebook that you're having a party so that the other residents can write to you if it's too noisy, for example.

We are lucky enough to have a bicycle cellar where you can store your bike(s) if you don't use it very often. There's also a bike workshop that you can use - just put all the tools away afterwards.

You can make an agreement on when to clean the hallway you share with your closest neighbours.. Remember that when you move out, the corridor must be cleaned.

If you have windows facing the street, they can be opened and turned almost 180 degrees for cleaning. On the west side of the window, pull back the small metal thingy so that the window can be opened all the way up and then it can be turned round. There is also a small vent at the top of the window, which can be a good idea to leave open: it provides a better indoor climate and the hood can suck in the air and extract more efficiently. Simply press on either side of the vent to release it.

As you may have noticed, we have parking and a parking card that we can use if you have a car or guests. Remember that you can only use the parking card for your guests and others in the dormitory - you cannot rent a parking space to others.
