Fire alarm

The hall of residence has a fire alarm which is activated if a fire occurs. The fire alarm is **internal** and therefore, **does not automatically alert the fire department**.

The fire alarm can also be activated by pressing the red button, which is located on the walls in the hallways.

In the event of a fire

In the event of a confirmed fire call the fire department – **call 112** – and report:

- What has happened.
- In case of injuries, how many.
- Address and phone number, from where the call is made.

If the alarm as not activated, then activate it in the buildings threatened by fire.

Evacuate to the parking lot or street, which are considered safe territory

- Rooms are to be abandoned **without** locking the doors. This is done by pulling the little switch which deactivates the lock of the door. (The fire department will check if you have left the room).

Engage in rescue and extinguishing if it is possible and reasonable

- If it is not possible to extinguish the fire, then try to contain it by closing doors and windows.

Receive the fire department and inform:

- The center of the warning system is in the room beside the main entrance. The door is marked "fire alarm".
- If there are injured persons who need medical attention.
- Where the fire is.
- The extent of the fire.
- Where the access ways are.

In case of false alarm

In case of false alarm within normal working hours call the caretaker at: 30 55 98 55
